### **Advanced Novice Cowhorse Division**

The Advanced Novice Cowhorse will be run under the same rules as Novice Cowhorse. Any rider that does not show in the Limited Non-Pro Working, Green horse, Open or Non-Pro Cowhorse is eligible. For the year end high point riders will show in the Limited Non-Pro Pleasure, Trail and Reining. Points from those classes will be combined with the points from the Advanced Novice Working Cowhorse to determine the year end high point winner for the Advance Novice Division.

### **Limited Open Cowhorse Division**

The Limited Open Cowhorse class will be run under the same rules as Limited Non-Pro and Green Horse Cowhorse. Any horse/rider combination that does not show in the Open or Non-Pro Working Cowhorse is eligible. For the year end high point riders will show in the Open or Non-Pro Pleasure, Trail and Reining. Points from those classes will be combined with the points from the Limited Open Working Cowhorse to determine the year end high point winner for the Limited Open Division.

### **2-3 year old Division**

The 2-3 year old pleasure, reining, trail and cowhorse will be run under the same rules as the novice division. Two & three year old horses that do not show in any other working Cowhorse class will be eligible. Separate classes for open and non-pro riders may be held.
